

In following the requirements set forth by external auditors for the West Virginia Division of Highways (WVDOH), annual certification letters must be sent to each project sponsor for reply. 

ORDER OF ANNEXATION

At a regular session of the County Commission of Marion County, West Virginia, held for said County on the 13th day of November, 2013, the above-referenced Certification of the Town of White Hall, a municipal corporation, located in Marion County, West Virginia, was considered by the Commission.

The Certificate of the governing body of the municipality of the Town of White Hall was this day filed showing that an annexation has been made, in the manner required by law, to the corporate limits thereof, and that by such annexation the said corporate limits are changed by adding 8.38 acres of additional territory described as follows:

All of that certain lot or parcel of real estate, situate, lying and being in Grant District, Marion County, West Virginia, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at Original Corner 81 of the Town of White Hall Corporate Boundary and being the northwestern most corner of Cloverdale Heights Subdivision Lot 11 (Tax Map 09-27F, Parcel 139) situated in Grant District, Marion County, West Virginia. Thence: North 66°49'43" East 696.30 feet to a Point, South 46°19'53" East 187.72 feet to a Point, South 52°33'58" West 54.65 feet to a Point, South 01°49'24" East 60.02 feet to a Point and South 64°01'16" East 167.47 feet, following five common lines between the current Town of White Hall Corporate Boundary and Cloverdale Heights Subdivision to a Point in the northwestern Right-of-Way for Lanham Lane (County Route 250/24). Thence: South 35°01'22" West 47.71 feet a Point, South 31°47'28" West 20.43 feet to a Point and South 12°40'05" West 98.70 feet to a Point, following the common line between Cloverdale Heights Subdivision and the northwestern Right-of-Way for Lanham Lane to a Point. This Point is a common corner to Lot 4 (Tax Map 09-27F, Parcel 128) and Lot 3 (Tax Map 09-27F, Parcel 127) of the Cloverdale Heights Subdivision. Thence: North 63°43'17" West

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132.32 feet to a Point, South 18°06'59" West 116.34 feet to a Point, South 28°32'25" West 116.98 feet to a Point, North 55°35'32" West 151.22 feet to a Point, South 30°59'43" West 135.66 feet to a Point, South 23°59'43" West 70.00 feet to a Point, South 77°59'43" West 129.00 feet to a Point and South 76°59'43" West 100.00 feet, leaving Lanham Lane and following eight lines through Cloverdale Heights Subdivision to a Point in Cloverdale Heights Subdivision's southwestern boundary line. 

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The Commission received a request for funds from the Lady Polar Bear Soccer Team. Commissioner Tennant also added that the East Fairmont Boys Team made it to the State Tournament and should be assisted as well.

Commissioner Tennant moved that the Commission donate \$250.00 to each team and that those funds be appropriated from the Coal Severance Fund. Commissioner VanGilder seconded. President Elliott concurred.

For the record, note the Commission received from Government Services of West Virginia, Ron Preast the unaudited Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for Marion County, West Virginia for Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2013.

Charlie Reese presented an update on the Palatine Park Project by stating that the homes on new Street will be vacant and can be demolished by our contractor at any time. We will be having a meeting with an adjoining land owner this Friday as to what their plans. Charlie Reese asked Sandra Hulsey, the Mayor of Worthington to come up and he added that tonight is our second Meeting of all of the County's Mayors and Belinda's help and vision we have come up with the Mayors on the Move as our slogan. Sandra stated that she has been impressed with the assistance of the other Mayors as well as Charlie who has assisted her in obtaining expertise in areas that concern our small communities. She also added that we had a 100 percent attendance at last year's meeting and we are hoping for the same this year.

President Elliott stated that we have a packet from the Marion County Convention and Visitor's Bureau on the activities and locations our residents can visit in Marion County.
