

MARION COUNTY COMMISSION
AUGUST 13, 2014

The Marion County Commission sat in regular session pursuant to its adjournment on Wednesday, August 6th, 2014. Present were Commissioner Elliott, Commissioner VanGilder and President Tennant.

The proceedings of Wednesday, August 6th, 2014, together with those had and done under the supervision of Janice Cosco, Clerk and Recorder for the Marion County Commission on August 7th, 8th, 11th and 12th, 2014 were approved as submitted and signed.





ORDER CONFIRMING PROBATE OF WILLS





Columbus Carpenter announced that there will be a chicken roast and kielbasa sandwich at Palatine Park for the benefit of the Korean War Memorial on Friday and Saturday, August 15th and 16th respectively. He continued that are new benches and tables have arrived and the Maintenance Department has constructed and installed them.

Commissioner Elliott stated that he has been approached by the American Value Association ladies Mrs. Oliverio and Mrs. Herron who are members and are present today to make a contribution to the Korean War Memorial. The ladies stated that their organization is disbanding and they have some funds available and they want to donate their remaining funds to the Korean War Memorial. They are prepared to donate \$4,800.00 to this veterans group. Commissioner Elliot wanted to thank these ladies for their generous contribution. Charlie Reese and Columbus Carpenter and all present in court thanked these great ladies for their support and contribution.

Belinda Biafore stated for the record that she has contacted various organizations around the County to seek contributions for the purchase of the tables, benches and other items for the park. She added that when an organization does purchase an item a plaque will be installed on the item showing all that have supported this venture.
