SPECIAL MEETING  
FEBRUARY 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

*The Marion County Commission sat in regular session pursuant to its adjournment on Wednesday, January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018. Present were Commissioner Elliott, Commissioner and Commissioner VanGilder.*

*President VanGilder led the Court with the Pledge of Allegiance.*

*President VanGilder called the special meeting to order.*

*The Commission received the Precinct Consolidations from the County Clerk's Office.*

**BEFORE THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF MARION COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA  
ORDER CONSOLIDATING PRECINCTS 56 AND 58**

**WHEREAS, the Marion County Commission pursuant to West Virginia Code Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 5, shall utilize precincts for the basic territorial election unit; and**

**WHEREAS, the County Commission is required to divide each Magisterial District of the County into election Precincts, to number the precincts, to determine and establish the boundaries thereof, and to designate one voting place in each Precinct which shall be established as nearly as possible at the point most convenient for the voters of the Precinct; and**

**WHEREAS, Pursuant to West Virginia Code Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 7, the County Commission of any County may change the boundaries of any Precinct within such County or divide any Precinct into two or more Precincts or consolidate two or more Precincts into one or change the location of any polling place whenever the public convenience may require it; and**

**WHEREAS, West Virginia Code Chapter 1, Article 1, Section 2b, requires that no precinct contain territory included in more than one senatorial or delegate district; and**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to West Virginia code Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 7, the County Commission which is considering changes as noted above must adopt an order of intent to do so and run a Class II legal advertisement in the publication which covers the Precinct (s) area (s); and**

**WHEREAS, ORDER AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSOLIDATE PRECINCTS 56 AND 58 was published as a Class II legal advertisement in the Times-West Virginian on January 5<sup>th</sup> 2018 and on January 12<sup>th</sup> 2018; and**

**WHEREAS, the County Commission of Marion County, West Virginia did on February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018 sit in special session for the purpose of hearing all substantial and reasonable objections to the consolidation of Precincts 56 and 58; and**

**WHEREAS, no substantial and reasonable objections to the consolidation of Precincts 56 and 58 were heard in public hearing;**

**THEREFORE, the County Commission of Marion County, West Virginia finds that it is in the interests and convenience of the voters of Marion County to consolidating Precincts 58 and 56 into one precinct to be known as Precinct 56.**

**Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that Precincts 58 and 56 shall be and hereby are consolidated into one precinct to be known as Precinct 56.**

**It is further ORDERED that the physical boundaries of Precinct 56 shall be as follows:**

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Beginning at the intersection of Bethel Run, Secondary Route 20, Dunkard Mill Run, and Secondary Route 24, in a line of Precinct 53; thence westerly crossing State Route 218 to a point on the ridge between said Route 218 and Laurel Run, a corner to Precinct 53; thence northwesterly with the said ridge to the intersection of Secondary Routes 250/10 and 18/5, a corner to Precinct 62; thence northerly with the ridge between Dunkard Mill Run and Plum Run and with Precinct 62, crossing Secondary Route 18 to a point at the corner of Precincts 62 and 89 on the Paw Paw District line; thence with Precincts 89 and 90, and the Paw Paw District Line as shown on the Grant Town quadrangle sheet to the corner of Precinct 29 in the Middletown Magisterial District line; thence with Precincts 29 and 33 and said magisterial line, crossing Secondary Route 91 and U.S. Route 250 near Katy to a corner of Precincts 33 and 52, above the 4H camp; thence northwesterly with the ridge between Mill Fall Run and Buffalo Creek and Precincts 52 and 55 to a point in State Route 218, a corner to Precinct 53 at the top of Ida May Hill; thence with said Route 218 to the Farmington Corporation line; thence North on 218 to the center of Baltimore and Ohio Railroad; thence with said Railroad to Dunkard Mill Run; thence up Dunkard Mill Run to the intersection of Bethel Run, Secondary Route 20, Dunkard Mill Run, and Secondary Route 24, the place of beginning.

It is further ORDERED that the designated place of voting for Precinct 56 shall be the Farmington Community Building.

All of which is done pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 7, of the Code of West Virginia as amended.

**WHEREAS, no substantial and reasonable objections to the consolidation of Precincts 61 and 62 were heard in public hearing;**

**THEREFORE, the County Commission of Marion County, West Virginia finds that it is in the interests and convenience of the voters of Marion County to consolidating Precincts 61 and 62 into one precinct to be known as Precinct 61.**

**Accordingly, it hereby ORDERED that Precincts 61 and 62 shall be and hereby are consolidated into one precinct to be known as Precinct 61.**

**It is further ORDERED that the physical boundaries of Precinct 61 shall be as follows:**

**BEGINNING AT A CORNER OF PRECINCTS 59 AND 78 ON THE RIDGE ABOVE THE HEAD OF SALT LICK RUN ON THE TAX DISTRICT LINE BETWEEN LINCOLN AND MANNINGTON DISTRICTS; THENCE WITH THE SAID TAX DISTRICT LINE NORTHERLY WITH PRECINCT NO.78 AND THE RIDGE BETWEEN GRAYS RUN AND SALT LICK RUN, CROSSING U.S. 250, TO BUFFALO CREEK; THENCE NORTHERLY WITH PRECINCT NO. 78 AND THE RIDGE BETWEEN MOD RUN AND MAHAN RUN TO A POINT IN PRECINCT NO. 74; ; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY WITH LINCOLN AND MANNINGTON TAX DISTRICT LINE TO A POINT ON THE RIDGE BETWEEN PLUM AND LLEWELLYN RUN A CORNER TO PRECINCT 74; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY WITH SAID RIDGE TO THE INTERSECTION OF SECONDARY ROUTES 13/1 AND 12/1; THENCE FOLLOWING THE RIDGE AROUND THE HEAD OF PLUM RUN TO THE PAW PAW TAX DISTRICT LINE; THENCE WITH THE PAW PAW TAX DISTRICT LINE AND WITH PRECINCTS 74 AND 89 TO THE CORNER OF PRECINCT 56; WHERE A PIPE LINE CROSSES THE LINCOLN PAW PAW DISTRICT LINE AS SHOWN ON THE MANNINGTON QUADRANGLE SHEET, 1976 REVISED AND AT THE CORNER OF PRECINCT 58 IN THE LINE OF PRECINCT 89; THENCE DUE SOUTH, CROSSING SECONDARY ROUTE 18 WITH PRECINCT 56 TO A POINT ON THE RIDGE BETWEEN DUNKARD MILL RUN AND PLUM RUN; THENCE SOUTHERLY WITH THE RIDGE BETWEEN DUNKARD MILL RUN AND PLUM RUN TO THE INTERSECTION OF ROUTES 250/10 AND 18/5 AT THE HEAD WATERS OF CARBERRY RUN; THENCE SOUTHERLY ALONG THE RIDGE BETWEEN CARBERRY RUN AND LAUREL RUN WITH PRECINCT 53 TO A POINT IN BUFFALO CREEK AT THE MOUTHE OF EAST RUN, THENCE SOUTH CROSSING US RT 250 AT A PIPELINE AS SHOWN ON THE MANNINGTON QUADRANGLE SHEET, 1976 REVISED IN THE LINE OF PRECINCT 53, THENCE TO A POINT ON THE CORNER OF PRECINCTS 50 AND 59, THENCE WEST CROSSING CR ROUTE 50/1 TO THE RIDGE BETWEEN EAST RUN AND PARRISH**


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**RUN, THENCE FOLLOWING THE RIDGE WESTERLY CROSSING CR RT 50 TO A POINT ON THE RIDGE BETWEEN SALT LICK RUN AND GRAYS RUN AT A CORNER OF PRECINCTS 59 AND 78. TO BE KNOWN AS PRECINCT NO. 61**

**The designated place of voting for Precinct 61 shall be the Downs Community Building at Rachel, West Virginia.**

**All of which is done pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 7, of the Code of West Virginia as amended.**

**Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that Precincts 70 and 72 shall be and hereby are consolidated into one precinct to be known as Precinct 72.**

**It is further ORDERED that the physical boundaries of Precinct 72 shall be as follows:**

**BEGINNING AT A POINT IN THE CENTER LINE OF WEST VIRGINIA COUNTY ROUTE 11, SAID POINT BEING THE SOUTHEASTERLY CORNER OF MANNINGTON TAX DISTRICT AND IN THE SOUTHWESTERLY CORNER OF LINCOLN TAX DISTRICT IN THE HARRISON COUNTY LINE; THENCE WITH THE HARRISON COUNTY LINE IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION TO THE WETZEL COUNTY LINE; THENCE NORTHERLY WITH THE WETZEL COUNTY LINE TO A POINT ON THE RIDGE NEAR THE HEAD OF BARTHOLOMEW FORK AND WARRIOR FORK CORNER TO PRECINCT NUMBER 74; THENCE FOLLOWING THE RIDGE LINE DIVIDING BARTHOLOMEW FORK AND WARRIOR FORK TO THE HIGH POINT ON THE RIDGE WEST OF SEVEN PINES; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY WITH A STRAIGHT LINE CROSSING WEST VIRGINIA SECONDARY ROUTES 3 AND 4 NORTH OF SEVEN PINES TO A POINT ON THE RIDGE NORTHEAST OF SEVEN PINES, SAID RIDGE DIVIDING BARTHOLOMEW FORK AND LITTLE DENTS RUN; THENCE WITH THE RIDGE LINE ABOVE THE HEAD WATERS OF THE FOLLOWING STREAMS DENTS RUN, REX RUN, HIBBS RUN TO THE HIGH POINT ON WEST VIRGINIA SECONDARY ROUTE 6 SOUTH OF METZ; THENCE SOUTHERLY TO A POINT ON THE RIDGE AT THE HEAD WATERS OF DRAKE'S RUN AND DIVIDING DRAKE'S RUN AND HIBBS RUN; THENCE SOUTHEASTERLY ALONG THE RIDGE BETWEEN CLEAR RUN AND DRAKE'S RUN TO A POINT ON THE RIDGE SOUTH OF THE MOUTH OF FLAT RUN; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY LEAVING THE RIDGE TO HAM ROCK IN FLAT RUN; THENCE DOWN FLAT RUN WITH THE STREAM TO THE INTERSECTION OF FLAT RUN AND THE CORPORATION LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANNINGTON; THENCE WITH THE CITY LIMITS COUNTERCLOCKWISE TO INTERSECTION OF BUFFALO CREEK AND THE MANNINGTON CITY LIMITS AT THE BOTTOM OF THE RIDGE BETWEEN FLEMING FORK AND WHETSTONE RUN; ; THENCE SOUTHERLY UP THE RIDGE BETWEEN FLEMING FORK AND WHETSTONE RUN TO A POINT AT THE HEAD OF FLEMING FORK CORNER TO PRECINCT 78; THENCE SOUTH TO THE USGS 1300 CONTOUR LINE; THENCE FOLLOWING THE USGS CONTOUR LINE SOUTHERLY TO A POINT ON A RIDGE SOUTH OF FORMERLY HAWKINS SAWMILL PROPERTY NOW TAX NUMBER 11\_\_2700030000 ; THENCE LEAVING USGS 1300 CONTOUR LINE AT RIGHT ANGLES TO WEST VIRGINIA COUNTY ROUTE 11 TO THE CENTER LINE OF**

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**WEST VIRGINIA COUNTY ROUTE 11 AND CR 250/7; THENCE WITH THE CENTER LINE OF SECONDARY ROUTE 11 AND THE LINCOLN TAX DISTRICT LINE IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING.  
TO BE KNOWN AS PRECINCT 72.**

**It is further ORDERED that the designated place of voting for Precinct 72 shall be the Hough Park Community Building in Mannington, West Virginia.**

**All of which is done pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 3, Article 1, Section 7, of the Code of West Virginia as amended.**
