***Commissioner VanGilder moved that the Commission sign the Order; Order #360. Commissioner Garcia seconded. President Elliott concurred.***

***The Commission presented the Approval of the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget. County Administrator Kris Cinalli stated that the tax and levy rates will remain the same. He continued that we are able to grant a 3% pay raise for our employees. Kris Cinalli stated that the Coal Severance Fund will also show an increase due to an increase in coal production in Marion County. Kris finally added that we are good financial shape and should be in the future as well. President Elliott stated that we have prepared and submitted a good budget that is fiscally responsible and we are very pleased to have our County Administrator Kris Cinalli doing a very good job in his preparation of this document and entire process of the budget hearing through the submission of this budget to the Auditor's Office for final approval. President Elliott was very pleased to give our employees a raise this year.***

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***Commissioner VanGilder is pleased that the Commission did not raise the Levy Rate. President Elliott is also grateful for the Coal Severance funds that are the County's.***

***Commissioner VanGilder moved that the Commission approve the 2015-2016 Budget and authorize the County Clerk to sign the document. Commissioner Garcia seconded. President Elliott concurred.***

***The Commission received a request for advice and consent to accept the resignation of James Evans from the Whitehall PSD, effective March 31, 2015.***

***The Commission received a request for funds from American Cancer Society Relay for Life. Chrissy Gearde of the American Cancer Society Relay for Life came to request funds for their upcoming Relays in both Fairmont and Mannington.***

***Commissioner VanGilder moved that the Commission allocate the same amount donated last year to both events and that those funds be appropriated from the Coal Severance Fund. Commissioner Garcia seconded. President Elliott concurred.***

***Charlie Reese stated that we along with Thrasher Engineering have developed our Master Plan for Palatine Park and it will be available for review and for the record in the Clerk's Office. Charlie introduced Mr. Raymond Alvarez for his presentation about the history of Water Street. Mr. Alvarez made his presentation and answered some questions in regards to his presentation.***

***Nancy Bickerstaff thanked the Commission for all that they have done in this matter of the Park and she presented her bucket list request of maybe constructing an old style replica of a Rail Road Station that was present on either side of the river. She added that that was a request for consideration.***

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*Chris McIntire wanted to thank Mr. Alvarez for his for his tutoring of grants in which that has lead Chris as stated to obtain about 9 million dollars in grant funds over the years. Chris McIntire of Central Communications stated that they are in the process of reviewing their Year End Report and are trying to develop new ways to improve on their system and to learn from it as well.*

*President Elliott presented the grant award in the amount of \$10,000.00 from the Governor's Office awarded to the County Clerk's Office for digitizing their birth, death and marriage records.*

*Commissioner VanGilder presented light up West Virginia WV lights for the upcoming March Madness Game with Kentucky on Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup> to the local reporters and minister present at the meeting.*
